5. Situation Summary and Health and Safety Briefing (for briefings or transfer of command): Recognize potential incident Health and Safety Hazards and develop necessary measures (remove hazard, provide personal protective equipment, warn people of the hazard) to protect responders from those hazards.

A vehicle has left the roadway after a physical altercation at an outdoor concern venue. In an apparent attempt to harm one of the agressors, a vehicle with 2 of the suspects rammed an individual into a house, pushing the car and actor into the residence. The Windy Acres First Aid Bridgade was called about 45 minutes ago, and after a few alerts, got 2 first responders out to the site. The site has limited access, with only 1 dirt road in and out of the site. The accident site is about 4000 ft down a single lane dirt road that has become heavily damaged by the 3 day music festival and rains during the event. From brigade member Smith on scene, they have no idea how to help, but think they have 3 people trapped in or around the car. Unknown if anyone else was in the house.

The initial responders have requested the assistance of the Hunterdon County Techicial Rescue Task Force, and have tried to do stuff for the last hour or so on scene, without making much headway. They did set up a staging area for local and TF resources at 201 Corporate Drive, off Rt 22 West. An equipment staging area closer to the scene has been secured large enough for about 4-5 vehicles at the entrance to Belgin Block, at the end of the dirt road into the site.

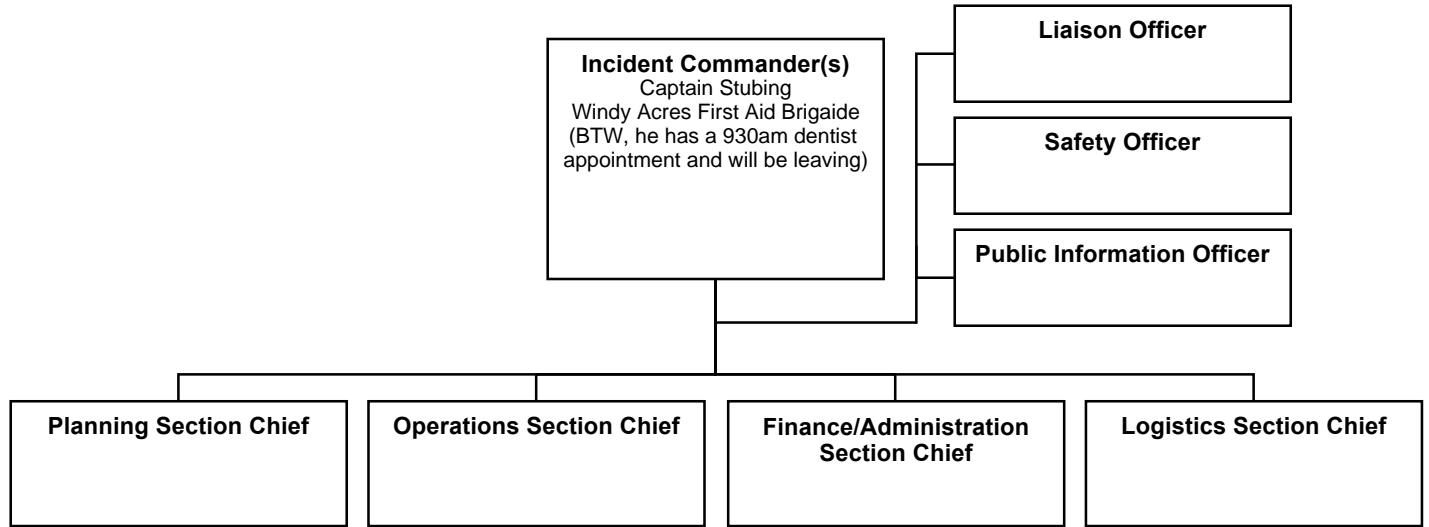
